## INTERNATIONAL MESSENGERS Spiritual Gifts Policy

As a staff member of International Messengers, we ask that you are in agreement with the following Spiritual Gifts Policy Please read it carefully and sign at the bottom if in agreement. Return this signed statement, along with other application materials, to the address indicated in the cover letter.

#### **TONGUES**

How we pray in private is our own individual concern. However, when any public exercise is contemplated, the gift of tongues must be governed by the Biblical limitations, namely, not without discernment of spirits (I Corinthians 12:3, 1 John 4: 1), not without interpretation (I Corinthians 14:28), one at a time and not more than two or three (I Corinthians 14:27). It should also be recognized that Christian love (I Corinthians 13:1,5) will prevent us from exercising the gift publicly if, thereby, we give offense either to fellow missionaries who may be present or to the body of Christ (I Corinthians 10:32, 1 Corinthians 14:33). Those serving with IM should not advocate the gift of tongues as a second blessing or as a sign of true salvation, neither should they participate in the laying on of hands for the receiving of this gift. (If you believe that a "second blessing" or a "second baptism" is necessary to make a believer complete in Jesus Christ, it would be best that you find another good missions agency that interprets Scripture in that manner. We do not.)

#### **PROPHECY**

While we may differ on the nature of the gift of prophecy in the New Testament, we are all agreed on the working of God's Spirit to lead us forward and bring us to a common mind. We, therefore, ask short-term participants and career staff members to refrain from phraseology that claims direct revelation and to substitute such wording as, "I believe that what God is saying to us in this situation is. . . " We may differ in our convictions about the nature of our utterance, but by using inoffensive wording, we can remain true to our convictions and maintain our fellowship. Prophecy is not to be accepted without others judging or weighing what is said by the Scriptures (I Corinthians 14:29).

#### WORD OF WISDOM/WORD OF KNOWLEDGE

Corresponding expressions for "word of wisdom"/ "word of knowledge" have been present for many years within evangelicalism. Participants and staff members are expected to respect each other's views and not to speak in a way that claims direct revelation on a level with Scripture, whatever the person's own feelings about their utterance. (Rev. 22:18-19)

#### **SLAYING IN THE SPIRIT**

The practice of "slaying in the Spirit" lacks Biblical foundation as a positive influence in the life of the believer (I Sam. 19:22, 24), therefore, we do not advocate or participate in this practice.

#### **TEACHING ON SPIRITUAL GIFTS**

In the interest of unity, we ask our staff members and participants, when teaching about spiritual gifts, not to teach their particular understanding of this topic as the only admissible view, thus offending fellow workers.

In order to avoid misunderstanding regarding the position of the mission as a whole, no staff member or participant may take a lead or be involved in organizing meetings for the promotion of charismatic teaching.

# INTERNATIONAL MESSENGERS Statement of Faith and Purpose

As a staff member of International Messengers, we ask that you are in agreement with the following Statement of Faith and Purpose. Please read it carefully and sign at the bottom if in agreement. Return this signed statement, along with other application materials, to the address indicated in the cover letter.

#### **STATEMENT OF FAITH** We believe...

- 1. **WE BELIEVE** the Scriptures, both Old and New Testaments, to be the inspired Word of God, without error in the original writing, the complete revelation of His will for the salvation of men and the Divine and final authority for Christian faith and life.
- 2. **WE BELIEVE in One** God, Creator of all things, infinitely perfect and eternally existing in three persons. Father, Son and Holy Spirit, having precisely the same nature and worthy of equal worship and obedience. WE BELIEVE that Jesus Christ is true God and true man. Having been conceived of the Holy Spirit, and born of the virgin Mary, he lived a sinless life and died on the cross as a substitutional sacrifice for our sins. He arose bodily from the dead, and ascended into heaven, where He continues His High Priestly ministry at the right hand of the throne of God.
- 3. **WE BELIEVE** the ministry of the Holy Spirit is to glorify the Lord Jesus Christ, convict men, regenerate the believing sinner, indwell, guide, instruct and empower the believer for godly living and service.
- 4. **WE BELIEVE** that man was created in the image of God but fell into sin through Adam and is therefore totally depraved, and only through regeneration by the Holy Spirit can salvation and spiritual life be obtained.
- 5. **WE BELIEVE** that the shed blood of Jesus Christ and His resurrection provide the only ground for justification and salvation for all who believe, and only those who receive Jesus Christ are born of the Holy Spirit, and thus become children of God.
- 6. **WE BELIEVE** that water baptism and the Lord's Supper are ordinances to be observed by the Church during the present age. They are, however, not to be regarded as means of salvation.
- 7. **WE BELIEVE** that the true Church is composed of all who through personal faith in Jesus Christ have been regenerated by the Holy Spirit and are united together as the body of Christ of which He is the Head.
- 8. **WE BELIEVE** in the personal premillennial and imminent coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and that this "Blessed Hope" has a vital bearing on the personal life and service of the believer.
- 9. **WE BELIEVE** the destiny for the believer is to be present with the Lord and for the unbeliever is to be separated from the presence of the Lord in everlasting punishment.
- 10. **WE BELIEVE** the great evangelistic and missionary commission given by Jesus Christ to the disciples and to the continuing church is that of making Christ known throughout the world by word and example and bringing to maturity those who believe in Him through instruction from the Word.
